# PRINTABLE WEAR CARD

As your Cadillac nears lease end, some wear is considered normal. Knowing what constitutes “excess” over “normal” can help your lease end go smoother. This guide and the Wear Card will help you identify what repairs may be needed to avoid excess wear charges.


After printing this card, cut it out and hold it against dents, dings, cracks, chips, stains or tire treads to assess the condition of your Cadillac.

## Instructions

1. For best results, print this document using your printer’s “Best Quality” setting. Disable any scaling or page-fitting options.\* The card should measure 6 3/4 (6.75) inches by 2 1/2 (2.5) inches.
2. Using scissors, carefully trim along the dotted line.
3. Use the ruler along the bottom to measure your vehicle’s wear.
4. To measure tire tread depth, insert the bottom edge of the card into tire tread. If your vehicle’s tire tread meets normal conditions, the tread depth indicator will not be visible.



### WEAR CARD

- Fewer than 4 dings per panel less than 2"
- 1 dent less than 4" or 1 scratch less than 6" per panel
- Interior cuts and tears smaller than 1/2"
- Wheel scratches and gouges less than 3"

**Normal wear conditions include:**

- Removable stains and minor carpet wear
- For most tires, tire tread depth of at least 4/32" from the lowest point. When inserting bottom edge of card into tire tread, the tread depth indicator should not be visible. Please see your Lease End Guide for additional important tire information.
